



BLANCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is offered by the Alumni Association for two or more graduating seniors of Blanchester High School who plan to continue their education at a technical/trade school or institute of higher education.

The recipients of the scholarship will be selected on the basis of:

- Completed Application (attached)
- High school scholarship (GPA: 3.0 or higher) – attach your transcripts to the last page
- Leadership
- Community service
- Probable success in technical/trade school or college/university

Recipient must attend the Alumni Banquet to be recognized by the Alumni Association. The Banquet will be held the night before graduation.

The application must be typed and in good order. Application is due in the Guidance Counselor's office on or before April 15th of each year.

Since its founding in 1917, The Alumni Association continues to foster a lifelong connection with friends and classmates of Blanchester High School, while promoting and supporting the continuing education of its graduates. Two or more non-renewable scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors interested in pursuing vocational or higher education. The applicants for this scholarship should be actively involved in school and community activities.

Any student who is preparing to graduate from Blanchester High School and/or The Great Oaks Career Campuses is eligible to apply for the Alumni Association Scholarship. Selections will be made by committee members and the recipients will be announced on the day of the Senior Awards Ceremony. Consideration will be given based on academic performance, involvement in schools sponsored activities and involvement in community related activities.
